The LBMS Spring Concert is a mandatory performance for ALL band students. Ticket reservations (free) are REQUIRED. Students do not have to be academically eligible to perform; this concert is deemed curricular by TEA.

The concert will be held at **Lake Belton HIGH SCHOOL** in their Performing Arts Center. You should park in the student lot on the far west side of the building (by the City of Temple water tower). We will use the main doors on that side of the school. Masks are required for all inside Belton ISD school buildings.

Uniform for the event:

- Beginners – band t-shirt tucked into blue jeans with any close- toe shoe
- Jazz Band, Symphonic Band, and Wind Ensemble – band polo tucked into black pants. Black shoes and long black socks, and a black mask.

Belton ISD concerts are approved for 70% capacity. To manage the 410 person capacity for the LBHS PAC we are asking audience and performers to ONLY be present for their portion of the concert.

Ticket Reservation Info: LBMS Band is managing the capacity for this event by using an online ticket reservation site. Tickets are REQUIRED for entry. You may reserve your free ticket and can gain access to the venue by presenting a hard-copy that you've printed or by showing the ticket on your phone/device to our volunteers working the door.
